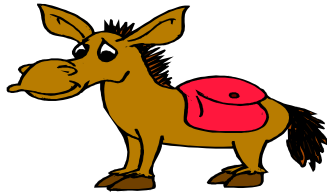
REPORT ON THE MEETING OF 18TH MAY 2011

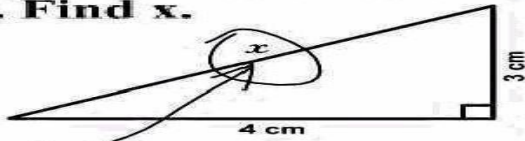
